Lindridge St Lawrence CE Primary School: Please tick your preferred sessions

The Early Years Provision is open from Monday – Friday, term time only. Parents / carers have the option to do full day sessions or either a morning or afternoon session. Lunch club is also available to tag onto a morning or afternoon session. We offer 2 year old funding to those who qualify and also up to 30 hours funding for 3 and 4 year olds.

We ask for a VOLUNTARY donation of £10.00 per child, per week to cover the costs of snack, cooking ingredients etc. This will go onto Parentmail at the start of each half term.

Parents/carers are able to use their funded hours in any combination of the sessions below between 7.30am and 6.00pm (dependent on availability).

The core sessions of 9.00am to 12.00 midday and/or 12.00 midday to 3.00pm cannot be split. If you require additional hours, over and above your funded hours, you are welcome to book these, and will be invoiced separately. The charges for privately funded hours are detailed below.

Please note that we do not offer a single session or day place. The minimum we offer is two half days, on different days, as in our experience, children find it extremely hard to settle if they attend for anything less than this number of sessions.

Wrap-around sessions before 9.00am and after 3.00pm take place in our happy and caring LindKidz group with children from the rest of the school. We will do our very best to accommodate your preferences.
