

# Reading at Lindridge

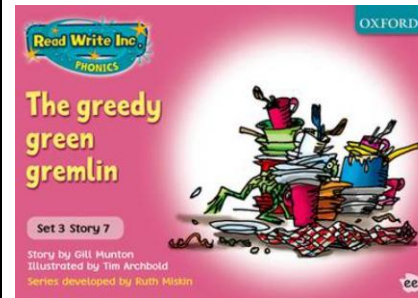
## Key Stage One

In your child's book bag, you will find:

- A book for pleasure – share this together. Your child might want to join in with some of the words or repeated phrases. **The purpose of these books is to develop a love for reading.** We change these books at least weekly, but children can choose a new book as often as they like.
- A levelled phonics book/banded reading book - As the children progress through the RWI scheme, they will read their levelled phonics books and then move onto banded books that offer a range of book types. This encourages the children to apply all their taught phonics skills. The children will have the same book for 2-3 days. **The purpose of these books is to develop fluency and confidence.**
- Common Exception Words for Y1 and Y2. These word mats are to practise reading by sight. Please practise reading these as often as you can.

**We expect children to read to a family member 3-5 times a week. Children read daily in school in Y1 phonics sessions. Y2 children read to an adult in school daily in their reading sessions. Please write in your child's reading diary when you have read. Thank you.**
