We also had Karen Argent from the Letterpress Project visit all classes in school yesterday with her trolley full of exciting books!! The children loved them!

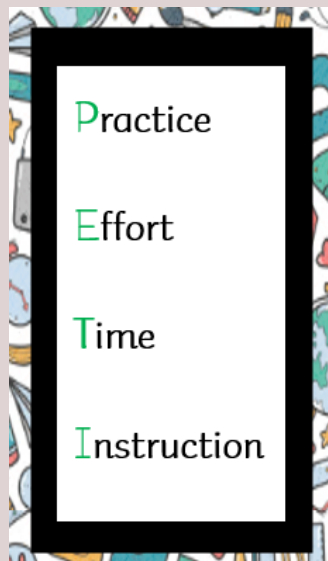
