Curriculum Terms of reference:

- To consider and advise the governing body on standards and other matters relating to the school's curriculum, including statutory requirements and the School's Curriculum Policy
- To consider curricular issues which have implications for Finance and Personnel decisions and to make recommendations to the relevant committees or the Governing Body
- To make arrangements for the governing body to be represented at School Improvement discussions with the LA and for reports to be received by the governing body
- To act as a critical friend for curriculum development
 - O To consider external recommendations (School Improvement, SIAS, Ofsted) for inclusion in SDP or for exceptional implementation
 - o To consider the SDP and SEF with specific reference to Curriculum and standards
 - o Recommend acceptance of SDP (and other plans as appropriate) to FGB
- To review regularly the Assessment Policy and to ensure the policy is operating effectively
- To review effectiveness of Pupil Premium / Primary PE funding for targeted pupils and added value of teaching & learning for all
- To oversee arrangements for individual governors to take a leading role in specific areas of provision, e.g. SEN, literacy, numeracy
- To receive regular reports from the above and advise the FGB
- To oversee the scope for educational visits
- To report back to the governing body

Ethos and Nurture Terms of reference:-

- Matters relating to ethos and Nurture, including any statutory requirements.
- To consider Ethos and Nurture issues which have implications for Finance and personnel decisions and to make recommendations to the Staffing, Finance & Premises committees or the Governing Body
- To oversee arrangements for Governors to take a leading role in specific areas of provision
 - Safeguarding
 - Keeping healthy
 - Enjoy and achieve
 - Make a positive contribution
 - Skills for life
- Any additional items that arise to do with the Ethos and Nurture agenda
- To oversee provision of children with Special Needs
- To maintain the distinctive Christian values of the school
